Jump Rope for Heart Information

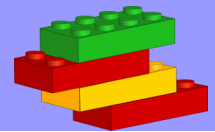

We participate for two reasons. 1) We do a Jump Rope for Heart event to keep the kiddos hearts healthy and this is a FREE event--just need to turn in permission slip. 2) Get optional donations to support kids with sick hearts and earn thank-you gifts. You can register online by searching "Hudson" at www.heart.org/jump or download the smartphone app "jump/hoops". The envelopes/donations and parent/guardian permission slips must be returned to school by Wednesday, February 22. The early return date is for the counting of donations, ordering of thank you gifts and making JRFH teams. The thank you gifts will arrive about a month after the event. Students do not need to collect donations to participate, but remind them the reason we participate in the activity is to help the American Heart Association fight heart disease. Jump Rope for Heart is a Hudson Academy sponsored activity for community service event. All money raised goes to the American Heart Association and money needs to be collected ahead of time.
