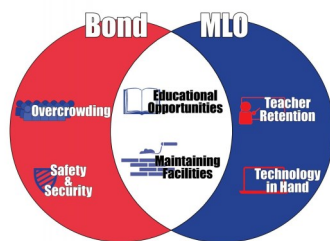
2016 Ballot Questions 3F & 3G
