Remote Learning Expectations

Hudson Families,

When your student is asked to quarantine and participate in remote learning, the following is the expectations that will be followed by parents, students and staff. When your student is absent from remote learning class, you are required to call the office. **If you do not have access to internet service, please contact the classroom teacher .**

Hudson's Guidance for Remote Learning Plan

Tuesday - Friday

- Remote Learning Days will begin at 8:00am and end at 3:00pm.
- Attendance will be taken twice daily.
- Teachers will do a 30 - 45 min Morning Meeting starting at 8 am daily with students thru Google Meets.
- The use of Google Classroom will be used by 2nd thru 5th for remote learning.
- The use of See Saw and Google Meets will be used by PreK-1st for remote learning.
- Classroom teachers will share Google classroom meet links with the principal and parents.
- Classroom teachers will share Google classroom and See Saw links through Class Dojo.
- Class Dojo will be the communication app PreK - 5 teachers use with families.
- Teachers will have 3 hrs. am & 3 hrs. pm daily instructional time. This will include whole group, small group & independent practice, where teachers are available to help students.
- Teachers will be conducting whole group instructional activities daily and small group meetings and instructional activities will be happening multiple times a week.
- Small group sessions will be a minimum of 20-30 minutes and have flexible grouping.
- Specials time and schedule will remain the same for remote learning.
- Teachers will create a remote learning schedule that will be shared with principal and parents through Class Dojo.
- Starting Monday, September 14th, all students kinder through 5th grade will participate in remote home learning. Monday's schedules will remain consistent throughout the school year. Classroom teachers will share a schedule with parents.
